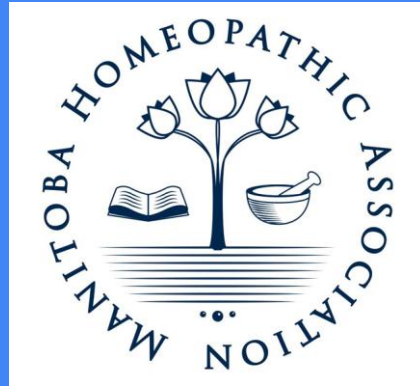

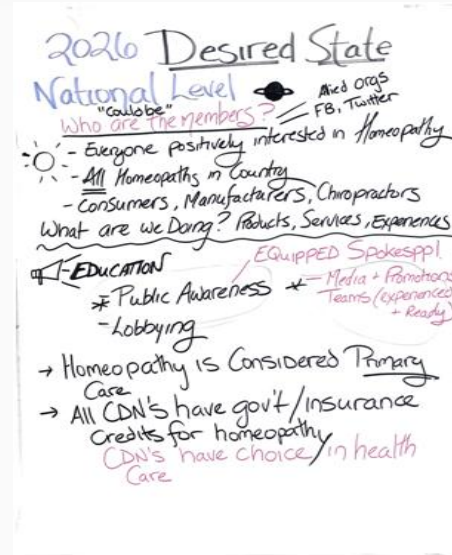

Vaccine Response from MHA

As homeopathic physicians, we do not make recommendations to parents about whether or not to vaccinate, but rather support parent's choices and discuss both the potential risks and potential benefits of vaccines. We encourage increased awareness of potential adverse allergic responses to vaccines and offer support to parents and families who are dealing with the consequences of adverse vaccine events. Homeopathy supports natural detoxification, and healthy neurological and gut function, as well as supporting balance in immune activity following a vaccination. In cases where parents choose not to vaccinate, or to delay vaccines, we continue to offer general immune support to children or adults who come in for homeopathic treatment and care, acknowledging that general immune support is not the same as vaccination for specific diseases and cannot be expected to provoke specific antibodies to specific pathogens in the same way that vaccine do.

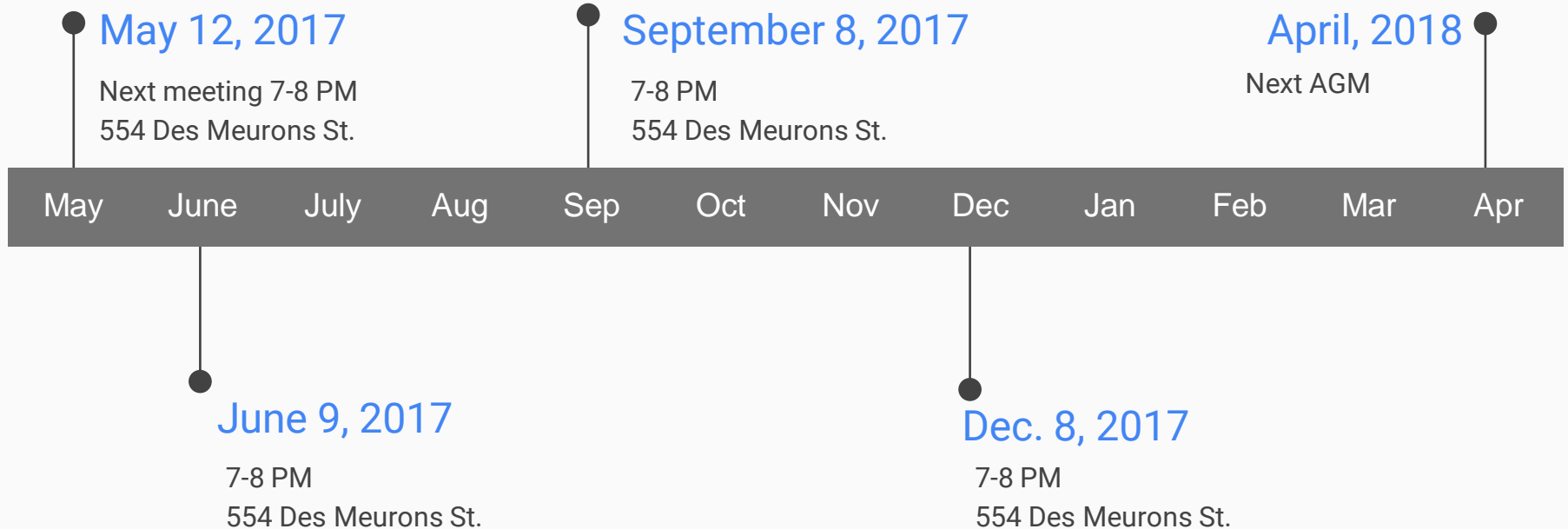
